# New NHS Hub brings care closer to Yeadon



Katie White MP opens the new Elective Care Hub at Wharfedale Hospital

The last Labour Government rebuilt Wharfedale Hospital and built Yeadon Health Centre. Today Labour is re-investing again in the NHS. It will take time but we have so far delivered:

- The new Elective Care Hub at Wharfedale Hospital – bringing hospital care closer to Yeadon residents, providing surgery for general conditions, minor cancers, urology and benign gynaecology. It will treat an extra 3,500 patients to reduce waiting times.
- 2 million more appointments a year.
- An end to the junior doctors' dispute.

### Labour will give the NHS:

- Over £25 billion more funding.
- £1.5 billion for more scanners and radiography machines to speed up diagnostic tests.
- £126 million for hospices.

## 27 BUS SERVICE

First Bus has cut the 27 bus service through Yeadon to every 40 minutes.



- Local Labour councillors are demanding the 30-minute service returns. They're actively campaigning for better services across the area.
- West Yorkshire's Labour Mayor, Tracy Brabin, is bringing bus services under public control.
- From Spring next year contracts will mean bus services will be run based on need, not profit.
- Tracy's "Mayor's Fares" initiative has pegged individual journeys at £2.50

## Yeadon's New Banking Hub

Yeadon's new Banking Hub at Yeadon Town Hall Theatre has been warmly welcomed by Katie White MP. It's part of Labour's pledge to open 350 banking hubs nationally.



The Hub opens Monday to Friday, 9am-5pm, offering a range of services including cash deposits, bill payments, and face-to-face banking support.

Katie is working with Cash Access UK to find a permanent location for the Yeadon Hub.

Local parents have welcomed the new play equipment installed at Henshaw Play Area, just off Henshaw Avenue. Leeds City Council Playground Team have been busy over winter making improvements. The work has replaced some of the old equipment and refurbished the rest.
